Beasts of Forest Roam Freely as Children Played

ANN ARBOR — Michigan pioneers of the 1830's weren't all mighty hunters by any means, according to handwritten reminiscences of one of the early settlers.

The Rev. Barton Taylor, who as a child lived with his parents on farmland now in the town of Ply-

mouth, has left a colorful account of those days in a group of anecdotes now in the University of Michigan Historical Collections.

He writes: "My father, though a pioneer, was no hunter and never shot at a deer except to drive them out of his fields of grain. Foxes, wildcats, wolves and bears made their homes in adjacent swamps but were seldom seen in those woods. We children moved at pleasure, fearing nothing and nothing fearing us."

"If we started a group of deer from repose, they would jump up, stretch themselves, and then around to look at us, and perhaps stamp their feet at us as if to test our intention. If we made no demonstration, they would go to feeding nearby."
