**PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION RELATIVE TO ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE.**  
Shall section 5 of article 5 of the State Constitution be amended relative to requiring as qualification of any person for the office of member of the Legislature, that the person be at least 21 years of age and that he not have been convicted of subversion or of a felony involving a breach of public trust?

Also for the Purpose of Voting on the Following City Proposals

**SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT SALE PROPOSITION.**  
Shall the City of Birmingham, Michigan, sell to the North Evergreen Sewage Disposal Authority for the sum of \$349,750, its Sewage Treatment Plant including approximately seven acres of land upon which it is located, described as the northerly 400 feet of the southerly 675 feet of the easterly 770 feet of Section 34, T2 N R 10 E, Bloomfield Township, Oakland County, Michigan?

**CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSITION.**  
Shall there be added to Chapter XII of the charter of the City of Birmingham, Michigan, a new section to read as follows:

Section 1-a. The Commission may also without a vote of the electors, contract for the disposal of sewage from all or any part of the city, with any Authority created under the laws of the State, of which the city at the time is a constituent municipality?
