**Place Price Tag On B'ham Services**

If B/W Controller wants Birmingham water and sewer service, it will have to pay about \$4,000 to "buy in" to present utility systems, Birmingham city commission determined Tuesday night.

Double water and sewer rates would be charged, too.

The commission figured that were B/W Controller to be annexed to the city, the charges then would drop to only \$664.

Last week, Troy City Manager O. G. Holway said his city couldn't yet furnish these services, and asked Birmingham to perform it on a temporary basis.

**Adjoining Zone Hearing to Dec. 3**

Another postponement came this week in the proposed zoning and rezoning of property at the northeast corner of Adams and Bowers in Birmingham.

City commissioners adjourned a decision until Dec. 3 to permit the city plan board to review proposed zoning amendment.

This would permit construction of one-bedroom apartments in the city, a requirement one of the property owners demands before he will agree to rezoning his parcel from business A to multiple family.

The other parcel, recently annexed from Troy township, is unzoned. The commission feels both parcels should have the same zoning.

**Area Volunteers Set Porch Drive For MD Victims**

Sometime Thursday evening, Nov. 29, a volunteer for muscular dystrophy will call at your home to ask for a few coins-in her canister. Commenting on the separate drive for muscular dystrophy which follows closely on the heels of the United Foundation drive, William C. Newberg, Birmingham-Bloomfield Hills campaign chairman, gave several reasons for the move.

"About 75 per cent of the funds collected go into medical research. The 'cost' of realizing the goal cannot be measured in fixed sums and therefore cannot be bound by budgets which united drives necessarily require," Mrs. Newberg said.

"ALSO," SHE ADDED, "a large part of the program is bringing to the public an awareness of this scourge which has been traced back to Biblical days. Until the national association's founding in 1950, few were aware of the disease, which takes the lives of over 100,000 Americans annually.

"The 25 per cent of funds not allocated to research," Mrs. Newberg said, "remain in the community to assist families of the unfortunate victims, who are mostly children."
