**BUSINESS BRIEFS**

**Kuhlman Electric Builds Headquarters in B'ham**

Kuhlman Electric Co. announces the election of a new company treasurer, and discloses plans to re-locate its headquarters office in a new office building near Birmingham.

Arthur Kaufmann, 1810 Graceland road, Birmingham, former associate with Arthur Anderson and Co. of Detroit, Kuhlman's auditor, was named to the treasurer post. This appointment releases G. R. Fluhr, 1048 North Cranbrook, Bloomfield township, company president and board chairman, for other administrative duties. Fluhr has acted as treasurer since 1939.

Other recent appointments in Kuhlman's program of developing a strong executive group include: A. V. Hughes, vice president and director of engineering; J. H. Watkins, vice president in charge of sales; H. E. Greenwalt remaining as executive vice president, general manager, and secretary.

THE NEW OFFICE building, now under construction, is part of Kuhlman's program of plant expansion and improvement, and is scheduled for completion in April, 1957. It will house Kuhlman's general offices now located in Bay City, Michigan, and will release much needed space for expanding the company's Bay City warehousing and manufacturing operations.

Kuhlman moved to Bay City from Elkhart, Indiana in 1915. Since then, floor space has been increased several times over. It was in 1938 that Kuhlman added the Detroit Electric Furnace Division to its Bay City operations.
