# PROPOSED CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SOUTHFIELD OAKLAND COUNTY MICH.

#### PREAMBLE

We, the people of the City of Southfield, Oakland-County, Michigan, under God, by virtue of the authority granted by the Constitution and statutes of the State of Michigan, in order to promote efficient self-government, do hereby ordain and establish this Home Rule Charter for the City of Southfield.

## CHAPTER 1

#### Name and Boundaries

SECTION 1.1 NAME AND BOUNDARIES:

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The municipal corporation heretofore created under
the provisions of Act 279 of the Public Acts of 1909,
as amended, known as the "City of Southfield", is a
bedy corporate, and shall continue a municipal corporation in perpetuity. Said municipal corporation shall
embrace the following described territory in the Township of Southfield, County of Oakland, State of Michiean, together with such territory as may from time.

ship of Southfield, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, together with such territory as may from time to time be attached thereto, and less such territory as may from time to time be detached therefrom, in accordance with law:

"Town 1 North, Range 10 East, Southfield Township, Oakland County, Michigan," which Township is bounded on the north by Fourteen Mile Road, on the east by Greenfield Road, on the south by Eight Mile Road (also known as Baseline Road), and on the west by Inkster Road, excepting therefrom the following described territories:

(a) Those territories previously incorporated;

(b) All that part of the northwest one-quarter of ection 6 of said Township, lying north of the Fourn Mile Road:

Telegraph Road; thence northerly along said westerly line of Telegraph Road to the northerly line of said Section 5; thence easterly along northyl line of said Section 5 and 4 to the point of beginning." # CHAPTER 2

## Municipal Powers and Authority

SECTION 2.1 GENERAL POWERS:

Unless otherwise provided or limited in this Charter, the city and its officers shall possess and be vested with any and all powers, privileges, and immunities, expressed or implied, which cities and their officers are, or hereafter may be, permitted to exercise or to provide for in their charters under the Constitution and statutes of the State of Michigan including all powers, privileges, and immunities which cities are, or may be permitted to provide in their charters by

Act 279 of the Public Acts of 1909, as amended, as fully and completely as though these powers, privileges, and immunities were specifically enumerated in and provided for in this Charter; and in no case shall any enumeration of particular powers, privileges, or im-munities herein be held to be exclusive.

The city and its officers shall have power to exercise all municipal powers in the management and control of municipal property, and in the administration of the municipal government, whether such powers be expressly-enumerated herein or not; to do any act to advance the interests of the city, the good government and prosperity of the municipality and its inhabitants, and through its regularly constituted authority, to pass and enforce all laws, ordinances, by-laws, orders, and resolutions relating to its municipal concerns, subject to the general laws of the state and the provisions of this charter.

#### **CHAPTER 3**

#### Registration, Nomination and Election

SECTION 3.1 WARDS AND PRECINCTS:

The City of Southfield shall consist of six (6) Wards, as follows:

Ward 1 to consist of Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13 and 14 Ward 2 to consist of Sections 3, 4, 9, 10, 5, 16, and the northern half of 15

Ward 3 to consist of Sections 7, 8, 17, 18, 20 and 21 Ward 4 to consist of Sections 23, 24, 25, 26, 35 and 36 Ward 5 to consist of Sections 22, 27, 28, 33, 34, and the southern half of 15

Ward 6 to consist of Sections 19, 29, 30, 31, and 32

The registration of electors of the City of South-field shall be conducted in accordance with the election laws of the State of Michigan, and no person shall be entitled to vote at any election held in the City of Southfield unless such person shall be a duly registered elector. thereof

## SECTION 3.3 NOMINATION TO OFFICE:

Candidates for any elective office to be voted for at any municipal election held under the provisions of this Charter, except as hereinafter otherwise provided, shall be nominated at a primary election, and no other name shall be placed upon the election ballot for the election of such officers except those nominated in the manner hereinafter prescribed; provided, however, that whenever the number of candidates for nomination to any office does not account this than the property of the control o that whenever the number of candidates for nomination to any office does not exceed twice the number to be elected to that office, then in such case no primary election for the nomination of candidates for such office shall be held, and such candidates shall be deemed to be nominated to such office, and the names of such candidates for any such office shall be placed upon the election ballot, to be voted for at the next regular municipal election, the same in all respects as though the said candidates had been nominated at a primary election.

SECTION 3.4 NON-PARTISAN PRIMARY ELEC-TION; WHEN HELD:

TION; WHEN HELD:

The first primary election for the nomination of candidates for elective office under the provisions of this Charter shall be held on the same day upon which the biennial spring primary election of the State of Michigan is held, being the third Monday in February, 1959, and thereafter on the third Monday in February of each odd-numbered year, provided, that if the date of holding such biennial spring primary election shall be changed by statute, thereupon the date so fixed for holding such biennial spring primary election shall be used for holding the primary election for the nomination of candidates for city offices under the provisions of this Charter.

SECTION 3.5 PRIMARY ELECTION DISPENSED WITH FOR ELECTIVE OFFICERS INITIALLY PROVIDED BY CHARTER:

The initials elective officers provided for in this Charter shall be nominated by filing nominating petitions as hereinafter required, and only those persons who shall have the qualifications for elective offices, as hereinafter prescribed, shall have their names placed
