**One-Party Phone Rates Would Go Up 50 Cents**

The Michigan Bell Telephone Company Friday filed a petition with the public service commission for an intrastate rate increase that would raise company revenues five per cent.

Albert H. Warner, local area manager, said the increase is needed to cover two upward wage adjustments for company employees and other increased costs.

"The pay adjustments were necessary to keep wages of our employees in line with those paid by the outside industry so that we can continue to attract and keep the type of employees required to furnish good service. The adjustments were based on wage surveys showing the general level of wages paid in communities served by the company."

WARNER ALSO emphasized the company "is taking the opportunity at this time to ask for a re-balancing of its rate schedules to reflect the growing value of service in growing communities."

Existing rates are based upon a 1948 telephone census. Since that time, the number of telephones in the Birmingham local calling area has increased from 66,905 to 134,885 for residence customers.

Under the proposed rate schedule, the various types of service at Birmingham would be increased per month:

Residence Service—individual line (flat rate extended area) up \$30; two-party line (flat rate extended area) up 25 cents.

A NEW residence service, two-party line with 55 message unit allowance, would be offered at \$3 per month. Additional units would be 5 cents each.

Business Service—PBX Trunk (flat rate extended area) up \$2.50; individual line (flat rate extended area) up \$2.25.

All interzone message units now 4 cents would be increased to 5 cents each.

PRESENT LOCAL zone residence and business services would be withdrawn and subscribers to those services could select any of the corresponding flat or message rate extended area services.

Extended area service provides calling at flat rate, or one message unit, if service is message rate, to Mayfair, Pontiac, Royal Oak, Southfield, and Troy as well as within the Birmingham zone.

In the Mayfair exchange, individual line flat rate residence service would be increased \$45 per month.
