Highlighting the bazaar will be a midway complete with games, movies, hot dogs and popcorn. The booths have been planned by the mothers, and will include a flower shop, toy booth and bake shop. The general store will display hand-made Christmas gifts, food and novelty items.

A SMORGASBORD dinner will be served from 5 to 7 p.m. by members of the school staff. Prizes will also be awarded at the bazaar.

THE DETROIT Country Day school opened in 1914 under the direction of R. Alden Shaw, at Ferry avenue. It moved to its present location, at 10235 W. Seven Mile road, in 1924. The school accommodates boys from kindergarten through the twelfth grade and girls from kindergarten through the eighth grade.

According to Robert Vanderkloot, president of the board of trustees of the school, 33 acres of land have been purchased at 13 Mile and Lahser roads for the new school, with plans to include a senior high school for girls.
