Yule Bazaar Set At Our Shepherd Lutheran Church

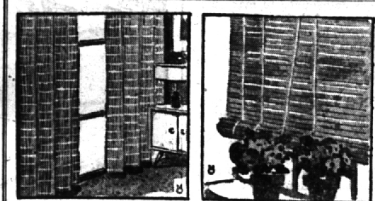
