Also the magazine subscriptions for the clinic's waiting room will be obtained.

The money for this project was raised by the Kappas when they gave a theater party at Will-O-Way last September.

KAPPA members are also helping to set up the library. Mrs. Herbert Gardner, Jr. has painted the bookcase for the library, and Mrs. George W. Davis will be in charge of cataloging.

The clinic is being sponsored by the Birmingham Junior League. Interesting to note is the close relationship between Kappa Kappa Gamma and the Junior League—one of the Kappa's members, Mrs. Charles C. Rumsey, was instrumental in founding the first Junior League in New York City in the year 1901.

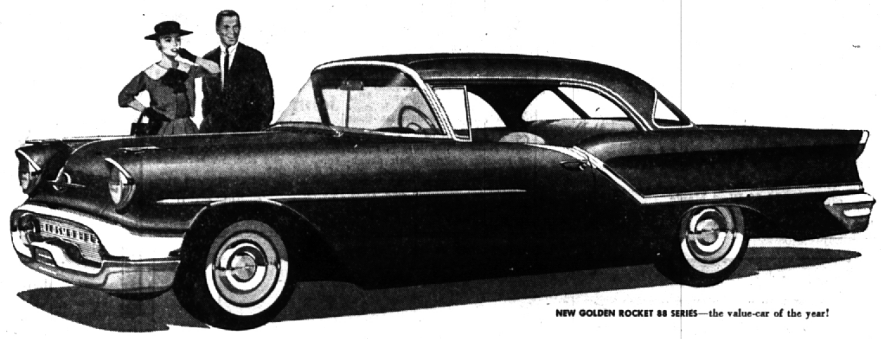

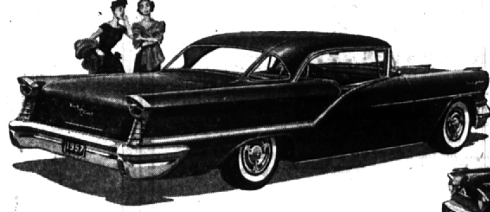

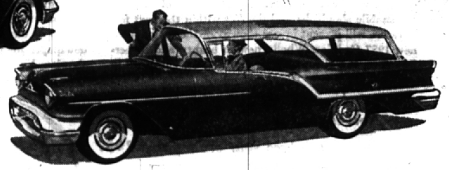
