'Antiquated' Sign Ordinance To Get Some Amendments

A new attempt is under way to modernize Birmingham's sign ordinance.

Monday night the commission asked the plan for the ordinance's recommendation revisions which have been pigeonholed for several years.

Amendments are expected to be ready for adoption in several weeks.

R. A. ULSETH, Detroit sign company representative, termed Birmingham's present ordinance as "antiquated" as one that is in the country.

"It doesn't take into account the many new sign-builders, signs and materials," he declared. "And I could legally build a sign one-foot wide and 100 feet long anywhere in the city."

He was representing Harold Kneibisch, who was petitioning for an ordinance change which would permit him to build a new sign for his store on Woodward.

Fernalde St. Condemnation Suit Started

Arguments in the condemnation of a lot needed in the opening of Fernalde street through to Hamilton got under way in Oakland circuit court yesterday.

City commission eliminated one of the parties in the proceeding on Monday night when it accepted a negotiated agreement with the Birmingham Eccentric.

The commission approved purchase for \$142,500 of a small tract of land off of a lot owned by the Eccentric has a warehouse. It also authorized \$8,000 in the amount on reconstruction of a warehouse wall, which must be moved to clear the new right-of-way.
