Predicts Nation Will Return Like To White House

President Eisenhower will win re-election in November, but will have a Democratic house and senate to work with, Washington newspaper columnist Marquis Childs believes.

In winning, the President will get less popular and fewer electoral votes than in 1952, and there will be more split-ticket voting than ever before, declared Childs.

This Washington analyst for the St. Louis Post-Dispatch, winner of many top newswriting awards, gave his opinions Thursday and Friday in the opening lecture of Birmingham Town Hall's third season.

At the celebrity luncheon at Birmingham country club following his lecture, Childs predicted changes in the cabinet and said he was told C. E. Wilson, secretary of defense wants to resign.

PRESIDENT Eisenhower's greatest capacity is his persuasiveness, warmth and skill in human relations, Childs said. Pointing out that only four incumbent presidents ever have been defeated, Childs said Eisenhower has wide popular appeal, is known as a man of peace and has the confidence of a large part of the world.

Best case against his re-election, Childs said, is the president's heart attack.

WHILE EISENHOWER'S outgoing warm personality appeals to the extrovert, Democrat Adlai Stevenson is an introvert, Childs compared. A reflective, scholarly man, Stevenson, if elected, will bring to the nation's highest office, a highly trained and able mind and a long background of experience.

"While we like to think a decision is made upon an intellectual basis," Childs said, "symbols, rather than issues play a large part in the decision."

"Eisenhower is a symbol of a family man as against Stevenson's divorce, and is an extraordinary symbol of the Presidency, carrying with it the great power of that office."

"Never in the past have vice presidential candidates made much difference," Childs said. "Perhaps this year it might."

Nixon, according to Childs, is a controversial figure, but is a most effective campaigner and is doing a "terrific" job. To a lesser degree, Kefauver also is controversial. A difficult man to analyze, Kefauver has a tremendous drive

for power, coupled with a homespun character, Childs said.

Democrats have had a hard time finding an issue of popular appeal, Childs declared. Childs said a valid proposal is made by Stevenson on ending the H-bomb tests as a first step toward atomic disarmament.

NEITHER party has made an issue of the integration and desegregation in the schools, but it is the greatest problem to face the next president, whoever he might be, Childs stated.

"In winning the allegiance of uncommitted people to the U. S., we must realize most of these people are people of color," Childs pointed out. "We are just a tiny group of white people in a great sea of color."

"Our leadership is seriously impaired and our enemies play up the headlines of violence."

"It is not enough for the supreme court to hand down a decision," Childs maintained. "A profound social change can not take place by law alone. A very great effort must be made by government, business, philanthropists and public education to work out the problem of integration of races."
