sixth season. The store, has avail-
able used clothing and household
items donated by members and
friends of the Junior League. All
proceeds from the shop are used to
support League projects in the sur-
rounding communities. In addition
the Junior League has a broad pro-
gram of volunteer service. During
the past year the League members
spent more than 28,000 hours of
volunteer service working with
community agencies.

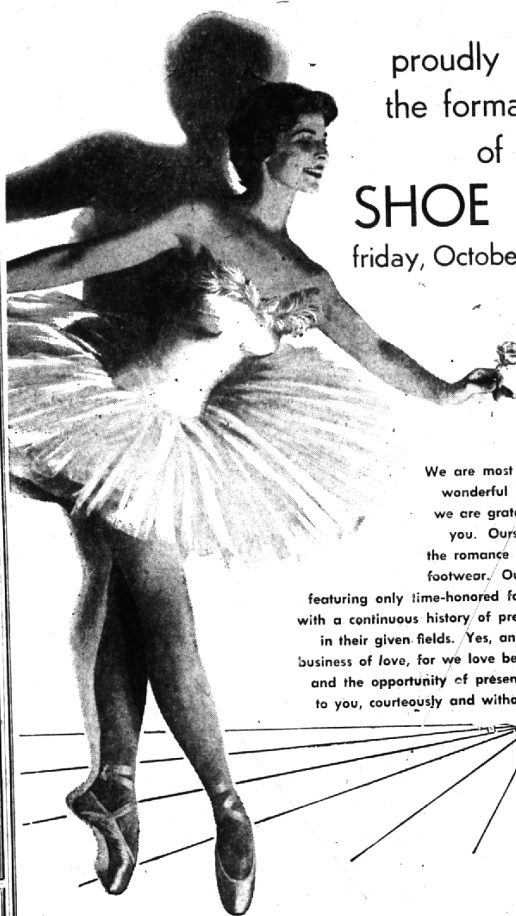
