

# Greater Industrial Gains in Oakland County

NEW YORK, Sept. 24—Oakland county is becoming industrialized more rapidly than are most other communities in the United States. Over a period of seven years, its manufacturing output has increased 104 percent. By way of comparison, in the same span industrial production throughout the United States went up 57 percent. In the east north central states the rise was 55 percent.

The findings are by the U. S. Department of Commerce and are contained in its preliminary report, recently issued, on its new Census of Manufactures. It compares data collected in 1955 based on the previous year's activity.

THIS IS the first complete compilation since 1947. It is, according to the U. S. Chamber of Commerce, "the only comprehensive measurement of factory establishments, employment, payroll, products and other industrial data." In Oakland county, it shows, manufacturing industries contributed \$582,808,000 to our economy in the year, compared with \$291,462,000 in 1947.

NEARLY ALL the industrial gains in the country showed gains. The transportation equipment industry led all others with a \$7.9 billion increase in value added.
