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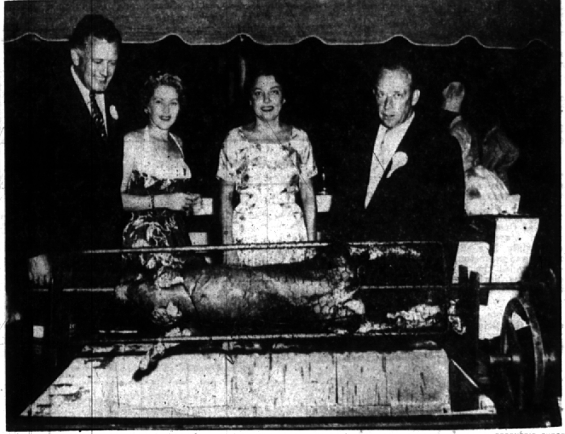

Miss Jackie Young returned recently to her home on Witherbee road after spending two weeks at Camp Narrin, the Girl Scout camp near Orionville.

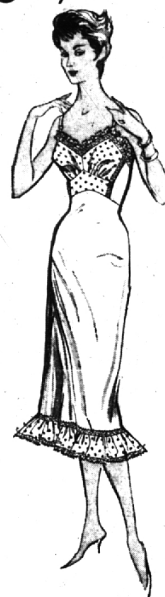

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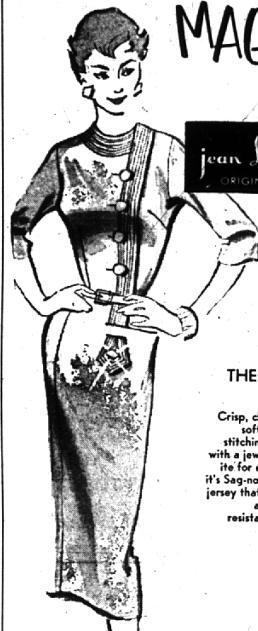
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
