DAC Eastertime Fete For Dads, Daughters

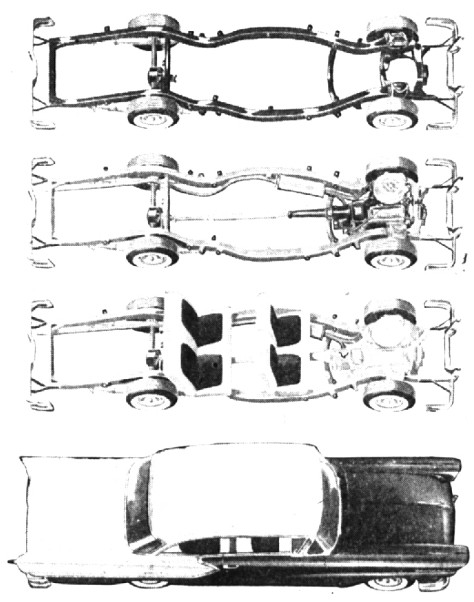

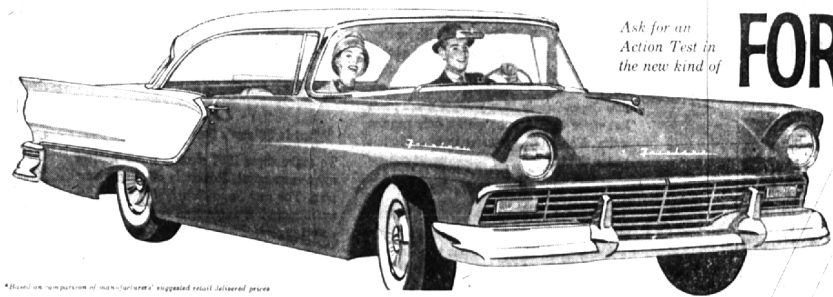
