**Area Seeks Way To Create Park At Bowers-Elm**

Unless property owners adjacent to the eight vacant lots on Bowers street between the Adams fire station and Elm in Birmingham come up with a way to finance acquisition of the property for a park, the property may be zoned business.

Birmingham planning board members last week tabled for one month Ford dealer Harold Turner's request for rezoning three of the lots at the Elm-Bowers corner. Turner seeks to use the property for parking and storage of new cars. Postponement was to permit residents time to study possibility of purchasing the property.

Approximately 60 to 70 property owners in the area attended last week's informal hearing. City Planner Herbert Herzberg said the lots, now zoned single family, are unsuitable for residential use.

**IN OTHER ACTION**, the board recommended to the city commission elimination of left turns at Henrietta, and removal of on-street parking on the north side of the lots at the Elm-Bowers corner.

**Will Complete Alterations to B'ham City Hall**

Birmingham has enough funds to finish up alterations to the municipal building after all, city commissioners determined Monday night.

They accepted the \$103,742 bid of Richard Eiserman Co. of Detroit to complete the first floor and basement remodeling.

The police department will be moved into expanded quarters in the former fire department wing, the county health department will be relocated where the policemen are now, and the city clerk's and city treasurer's offices will be expanded.

Commissioners decided they still have enough capital and contingent fund monies left to complete the E. Maple widening, construct Quarten lakes subdivision and Lincoln-Ann-Purdy sewers. These are estimated to total nearly \$170,000.

status of the vast majority of natives of these British West Indies islands. English appears to be spoken by most everybody, although there also is spoken a sort of polinated English-Spanish language among the colored people.

There is no color line drawn on these islands. You may observe colored folks among hotel guests, in other public places. Natives trace their ancestry to Africa and to a mixture of that race and various white peoples. You will observe that the non-whites vary in darkness... all the way from shading back to very light brown. Many of both sexes are very good looking.

Again, let me emphasize, these people are friendly and law-abiding citizens. Few of them get into trouble with the law. Already Rich and I have met a number of young lawyers in St. George who were educated in England, and a doctor who attended McGill University in Montreal, and now heads up the local hospital staff.
