Dr. to Discuss 'Gifted Child'

The present plight of the gifted child in our nation's system of mass education will be discussed by Dr. Ralph D. Rabinovitch, director of Hawthorne center, Northville, at the AAUW luncheon meeting, Wednesday, April 10, at the Community house. "Planning For the Gifted Child" will be the topic. Dr. Rabinovitch is a graduate of McGill Medical college, Montreal, Canada and did graduate psychiatric work at Toronto and New York university. He was a research fellow at Bellevue hospital, New York and head of the Children's service at University Hospital in Ann Arbor. Governor G. Moman Williams appointed him chief of Hawthorne Center in 1956. This newly established inpatient and out-patient clinic for treatment, training, and research in child psychiatry is under the Department of Mental Health, State of Michigan. Mrs. H. T.
