

Birmingham Phone Rates Are Boosted

Telephone rates and classes of service in Birmingham were changed in an order issued last week by the Michigan public service commission.

The service change eliminated "local zone" service heretofore available on private switchboard trunks, individual business lines, and individual and two-party residence lines. The change brings Birmingham service in line with similar service in other Detroit suburban communities.

"Most of our customers already have 'extended area' type service with its wider local calling area," A. H. Warner, Birmingham area manager for the Michigan Bell Telephone Co., said. "This part of the order merely applies to those customers who do not already have it."

THE EXTENDED area service permits users to call Pontiac, Royal Oak, Southfield, Mayfair and Troy telephones without an extra message unit charge, Warner explained.

"The commission order provides for an increase of twenty-five cents a month on one party, and \$1.00 for two party lines, plus the respective twenty-five cent and ten cent increases.

IN MANY CASES, the increase will amount to much less than customers have been paying in message unit charges for calls to the areas now automatically included in the new extended area package, Warner pointed out.

He said a new service provided under the order will enable users with limited calling requirements to have two party residence service with a fifty-five cent allowance at \$3.00 per month.

The commission order also applies adjustments to business facilities where services are "tailor made" to calling requirements of users, Warner indicated.
