16-year-old daughter Nancy have returned from a motor trip to Chicago, St. Louis, Little Rock, Hot Springs and Cincinnati.

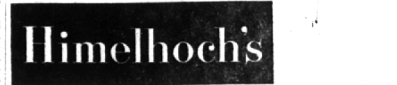
While in Hot Springs, visiting relatives, Nancy participated in water-skiing.
