Seven Baptist churches in the Birmingham area will take part in a "singspiration" at the Grace

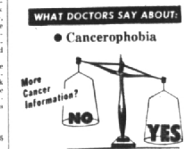
Baptist church Sunday at 9:15 p.m. Ken Orr will lead the inspiration under the direction of the Rev. Charles Whitfield.

WHAT DOCTORS SAY ABOUT:
• Cancerphobia



Q. Are public cancer educational programs helpful or harmful?
A. You be the judge. In 1955 a prominent American physician made a strong plea for less public talk about cancer. The doctor charged that public cancer education causes "cancerphobia" (unreasonable fear of developing cancer). Later the University of Wisconsin made a survey on public cancer education among cancer patients and members of their families. The vast majority (84 per cent) thought that present cancer educational programs had been "too early" or "too enough." When asked: "Do you think that public cancer education helps save lives?" 517 persons answered "yes" - only 9 said "no." From these and other opinions expressed by people who had firsthand knowledge of cancer, it seems that the advantage of turning the spotlight on cancer far outweighs the disadvantages.
