New School Plans Get Hills' OK

Plans for a new elementary school at Pine lake were approved at a special meeting of Bloomfield Hills board of education.

Bids are to be sought immediately, according to Superintendent Eugene L. Johnson, with contracts to be awarded along the first of January. If weather permits, construction is to start the middle of January.

Jan. 20 is the date set for a special election in which the board is asking the district to approve sale of the old Hickory Grove school and also donation of a fire station site on Eastover school property for a township station.

POSSIBILITY that a third item may be included on the ballot arose when a request for a trade of property was made by L. G. Sauber and E. A. Hupp, whose properties adjoin the new Hickory Grove school.

They would like to exchange about three-quarters of an acre of land with the district to straighten out lot lines.

The board asked Johnson to contact architects of the school to get their opinions and to study the site further. Johnson will report at the regular meeting of the board which has been advanced from next Tuesday to Monday, Dec. 16.

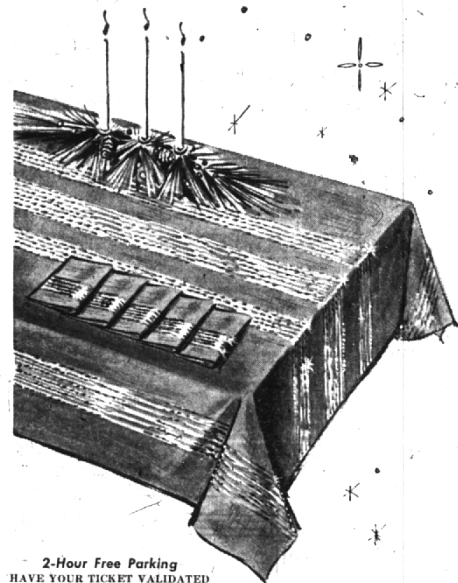
