Mr. Wiese is a natural at cheering and acrobatics and has won many medals and trophies for his achievements. He is in charge of as many as 300 girls at a time at cheerleading conferences and drills during summer camps. The girls are taught to do stunts on the trapezoid, plus cartwheels, flips and the splits.
