Plan Board Looks At Suggested Zone Law Changes

As the result of suggestions made by residents, property owners, the city attorney and plan board members themselves, Birmingham's planning board considered a number of revisions to the proposed new zoning ordinance at their meeting last night. Among changes recommended for their consideration by City Planner Herbert Herzberg were:

- 1) Elimination of the R-4, light industrial zoning originally scheduled for the block bounded by Elm, Bowers, Adams and Haynes. Listing a non-conforming use here would help to close the door on additional areas which might seek the semi-industrial classification in the future.
- 2) PERMISSION FOR "publicly owned and public utility buildings which are not injurious to the surrounding neighborhood" in residential areas, to be granted by the board of zoning appeals. This change was requested by Detroit Edison, Bell Telephone, and Consumers Power company.
- 3) Lowering minimum floor area requirement for new residences in the middle single family residence classification, R-2. Change would be from 1100 to 1000 square feet, to aid small lot owners.
- 4) In the lowest single family residence zone, R-3, minimum usable floor area required would be lowered from 1,000 to 800 square feet.
- 5) Lowering minimum lot area required for each unit of new multiple family residences. From 2,000 square feet to 1800 in R-6, the change zoning, and from 1700 to 1500 in R-7, the second classification.

She also asked where the city intends to put a test patch of asphalt on downtown sidewalks where there has been serious deterioration.

City Engineer Grover Serenbetski said it probably would be outside the west door to the city municipal building "where it can be watched more closely."

Mrs. Willett's final suggestion was that perhaps a dumbwaiter could be installed in the building to aid in moving heavy records and equipment up and down floors.

"I think we should at least find out what it would cost," she said.

Animal Not Found, Dog-Bite Victim Begins Treatment

Police received literally dozens of calls in response to appeals seeking the identity of the beagle dog which bit 11-year-old Lynda Ryan on Saturday, Nov. 23.

But Lynda, of 1448 Southfield, Birmingham has had to begin the series of 21 shots in the Pasteur treatment.

The girl looked at all the beagle dogs reported and declared they were not the one which bit her. "I know that dog anywhere," Lynda told her parents.

So far Lynda has had no unfavorable reaction to the four shots she has received. But the family are hoping that the dangerous shots can be discontinued with the finding of the brown and white beagle and the sure knowledge that it shows no rabies symptoms.

Anyone knowing of a brown and white beagle in the vicinity of Southfield and 14 Mile roads Nov. 23 should notify Birmingham police.

Pays \$75 Fine On Reckless Charge

A fine of \$75 and \$10 costs were levied in the case of Thomas Ray Masters, 21, of 1552 Benaville, Birmingham, last week.
