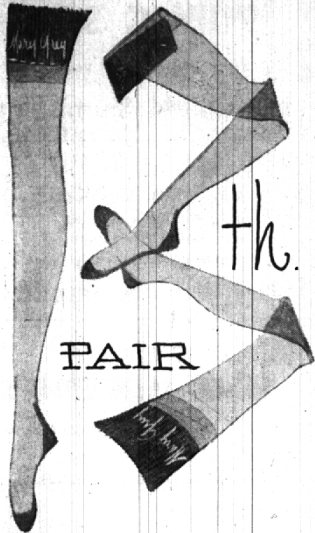

Q. Should a young baby be placed on his back or tummy to sleep?



A. Neither, according to an Atlanta baby doctor. Babies, said the physician, should be placed on their side to sleep. In the stomach position the legs tend to spread in frog fashion and the legs rotate or turn outward. The big toe rests on the mattress and the foot is forced into a flatfoot position. Something of the same thing happens when a young baby is placed on his back to sleep. The heels rest on the mattress and the feet tend to be forced into the flatfoot position. To prevent trouble, especially flatfoot, in later years the Atlanta doctor recommends placing the baby on his side to sleep. It helps to support the youngster's back with a small pillow or a tightly rolled baby blanket. Never put a baby on his back after feeding. He may spit up some milk and become strangled.

Q. Can doctors tell for sure whether it's going to be a boy or a girl?

A. British doctors have worked out a way to determine sex before birth. Their betting average is almost 100%, but the method isn't very practical. Some doctors wonder why it is necessary or even desirable to predict what will soon be known anyway. Sure-fire sex prediction would certainly take all the fun out of Nature's most precious lottery.
