Subject of the meeting, to be a joint gathering with the American association for gifted children.

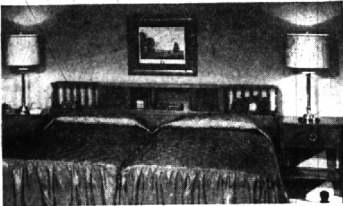

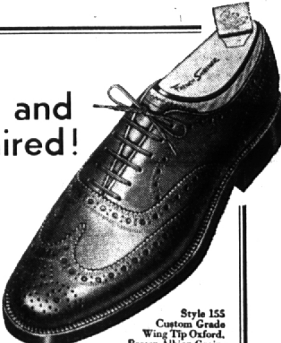
