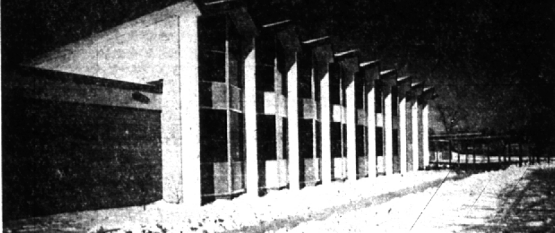


Troth Revealed At Family Party
