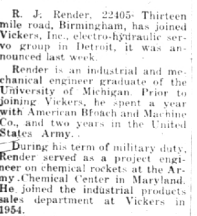
Fox, with the company since 1939, has been manager of sales and service the past several years. Harty moves to the new post after having been the firm's advertising manager since 1946.

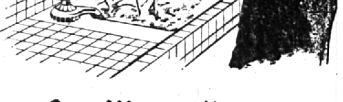
