 Additions would be completed in a year, the engineers estimate.

ANOTHER EMERGING possibility, Schone admitted, was that anticipated costs for enlarging the plant seem to be approaching the point where it may be no more expensive to build a connection down Evergreen road to Detroit, which would provide sewage treatment.

This would in essence be the Big Evergreen project, but financed only by the four northern communities. Lathrup, which has expressed strong interest in the Big Evergreen, quite possibly would become a charter member of the larger project, Schone believes.

Southfield township, suggested as the sixth member, could come in if the state legislature amends certain laws to permit the township's easier and sounder financing of its Evergreen costs.

BORINGS HAVE been made by the county drain commissioner's office for the Big Evergreen, Schone said. Consulting engineers also are drawing up its designs and costs. The N. Evergreen has until next July to finally decide which final treatment method — Birmingham plant or Detroit plant — will be used.

Michigan legislators would have to amend present law to permit authority to contract with another municipality for sewage treatment, Schone said. Now only contracts with a county drain office are valid, he explained.

AUTHORITY members this week received from Milton Adams, water resources commission executive secretary, a letter pointing out they should like to know what has been done to comply with the court's Jan. 1 deadline.

The day Adams sent his letter to us, the authority mailed him our report to the court," Schone explained. "The letters must have crossed in the mails."

The three cities under citation have joined with Troy to provide new trunk sewers to, and improvement of, the Birmingham disposal plant, which is being sold to the authority.

 Dr. Lapp reported on Russia's program for the development of future scientists for their country. On an enormous scale, Russia's bright young minds are trained and developed for scientific work with special cash bonuses for honor students.

LAPP URGED the channeling of promising American students into the field of science.

"We must learn to develop these new powers," he said as he pointed out atomic energy's tremendous potential for peace time use.

"We are going into a period of power without limit," Lapp concluded. "At a time when we are flaring too quickly through our combustible materials, we can foresee the taming of the energy of the ocean."
