Following its policy of closing unnecessary alleys, Birmingham city engineer this week requested a short dead-end alley and part of another in a block to the north. Both alleys extend east from Elm street.

**Sprague Drain Rates Decided**

Two different assessment rates have been set up for cleaning and pipe work on the Sprague drain, the Oakland county drain commission office announced this week. Rate for the entire Sprague drain district, comprising 4,270 acres, is to be \$10.82 an acre. A sub-district of 1,793 acres, which receives most benefit from the drain as it is on a direct outlet, is being assessed at \$50.13 an acre. Where property

is located in both districts, the tax will be \$45.75 an acre. The sub-district covers part of Avon township and the city of Troy, being laid out in a meandering line between sections 30 and 31, and 29 and 32.

REGISTRATION NOTICE FOR BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP PRIMARY ELECTION MONDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 1957

To the Qualified Electors of the Township of Bloomfield, Michigan: To the qualified Electors of the Township of Bloomfield, County of Oakland, State of Michigan: Notice is hereby given that in conformity with the Michigan Election Law, the undersigned Clerk, will, upon any day, except Saturday, Sunday and a legal holiday, the day of any regular or special election or primary election, receive for registration the name of any legal voter in said Township who may APPLY TO ME PERSONALLY during the time intervening between the Thirtieth day before any regular or special election and the day of such election. AND BE HEARD THAT I WILL BE AT THE BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP OFFICE, 4500 TELEGRAPH ROAD, MONDAY, JANUARY 21st, 1957, the last day for registration. From 8 o'clock A.M. until 5 o'clock P.M. on the last day of registration, I will receive applications for registration, as provided by Section 204, No. 10, Public Acts of 1941 for the purpose of REVISING THE REGISTRATION LIST and REGISTERING such of the qualified electors in said TOWNSHIP CITY or VILLAGE as SHALL PROPERLY apply therefor. I shall not receive any person but an ACTUAL RESIDENT of the precinct at the time of registration, and existing under the constitution, if remaining such resident to vote at the next election, shall be entered in the registration book. PROCEDURE TO MAKE PERSONAL APPLICATION, PROCEDURE Sec. 204. Any elector who is unable to make personal application for registration because of physical disability or absence from the Township, City or Village in which he is a legal resident, or primary election, may be registered prior to the close of registration before any election or primary election by securing from the Clerk of the Township, City or Village in which is located his legal residence, a notary public or other person duly authorized to administer oaths and returning such registration cards to the Clerk of the Township, City or Village, before the close of office hours on the last day of registration prior to the close of office hours on the day preceding the election. The notary public or other officer administering the oaths shall sign his name on the card for the signature of the registrant and designate his title. UNREGISTERED PERSONS NOT ENTITLED TO VOTE. Sec. 205. The inspectors of election at any election or primary election in this State, or in any District, County, Township, City or Village thereof, shall not receive the vote of any person whose name is not registered in the registration book of the Township, Ward or Precinct in which he offers to vote. (As provided under Act 116, P. A. 1951.) TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION, APPLICATION TIME. Sec. 206. Any registered elector may upon change of residence within the Township, City or Village cause his registration to be transferred to his new address by sending to the Clerk a request stating his present address, the date he moved thereto, and the address from which he was last registered, or by applying in person for a transfer. The Clerk shall strike through the last address and record the new address, ward and precinct number on the original and duplicate registration cards, and shall place the original registration card in proper precinct file. Such transfers shall not be made within 10 days next preceding any election or primary election, unless on the day immediately preceding Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday in which general registration is accepted during the next full working day provided that the elector shall not permit any person to vote in any Township, City or Village in which he had not resided 40 days next preceding any election. TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION ON ELECTION DAY. Sec. 207. Any registered elector who has removed from one election precinct of a Township, City or Village to another election precinct of the same Township, City or Village shall have the right to transfer his registration to the new precinct on election day by presenting a request for such transfer to the election board in the precinct in which he is registered. Upon receiving such request the inspector of election in charge of the election shall compare the signature thereon with the signature upon said registration record, and if the signatures correspond thereon upon said request and the applicant for such transfer shall then be permitted to vote in such precinct for that election only. The application for transfer shall be filed with the Township, City or Village registration in accordance with the provisions of this act. Whenever any street is changed, it shall be the duty of the Township, City or Village Clerk to make it clear in the registration records, and if it shall not be necessary for the elector to change his registration with respect thereto in order to be eligible to vote.
