**B'ham Federal Reports \$2.9 Million Increase**

Birmingham Federal Savings announced this week that effective January 1, 1957 its current dividend rate on all savings accounts was increased to 3 per cent.

The announcement by Birmingham Federal's board of directors followed its annual statement to members which disclosed assets at the end of 1956 of \$19,093,886, an increase for the year of \$2,914,354. Savings in the locally owned and managed financial institution rose \$2,814,186 to reach a total of \$14,773,119.

Walter L. Moreland, in his letter to members, pointed out that dividends for 1956 amounted to \$390,409, an increase of \$86,056 over those paid in 1955. He stated area residents had opened 2,250 new savings accounts during the year to bring the total savings accounts to 9,727.

RESERVES ARE UP \$135,017 over the previous year to a total of \$414,084. Birmingham Federal investments in first mortgage real estate loans climbed \$2,647,541 to a total of \$12,552,775 at the year-end.

Moreland called 1956 a "banner year" and said the firm's new main office at 99 West Maple, together with the increased dividend rate, should assure that 1957 will be even better. During 1956 Birmingham Federal Savings paid a 2 1/2 per cent dividend.

**Mills Backs Ike's "Back the Attack" Safety Campaign**

The first large industrial safety promotion in 1957 in behalf of President Eisenhower's "Back the Attack" safety campaign was staged by Mills Bakery, Pontiac, Friday.

At the meeting 170 of 375 Mills salesmen were awarded plaques in recognition of their record of 992 years of safe driving for two to 24 years without a chargeable accident. These plaques are to be mounted permanently on the sides of their trucks.

The 992 years represent 13,000,000 accident-free miles, and during the 40 years the bakery has been in existence, the trucks have never been involved in an accident resulting in a fatality.
