At Family Dinner

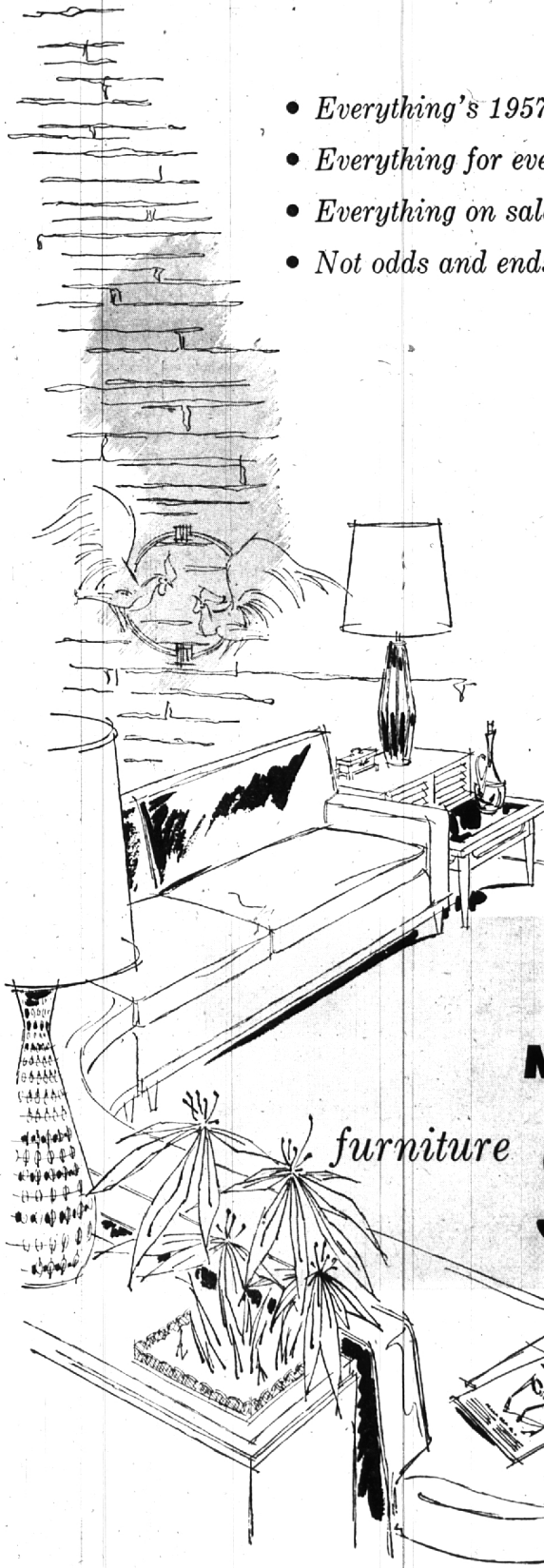
