

More Gas Coming For Birmingham

Out of a total 1957 expansion program amounting to \$25,000,000 Consumers Power Co. plans to spend more than \$13,000,000 in southeast Michigan, which includes Wayne, Oakland, and Macomb counties.

More than 300 miles of new gas lines are to be installed, to serve an anticipated 19,000 new customers, reports David H. Gerhard, division manager.

Birmingham is included in this program, according to Arthur H. Lee, district manager for South Oakland County.
