There are some easy effects in night lighting which I would like to pass on to you. Trees lighted with red lights inside gave a stunning effect as you passed in a car. Some of the best effects on outdoor trees was achieved by using the plain white lights only.

Especially the small match tip size bulbs from Italy (North and had 40,000 on their mail). A very simple result was accomplished in many, many instances by wiring the front of the store with aluminum foil or bright red oil cloth, then placing on it some motif depicting the season, ending up with a spotlight from the lawn focused on the door. Such a simple arrangement carried in good taste the entire scene.
