

CHICKWEED—The seed was sewn and it germinated last fall. Soon it will be setting and ripening new seed. PULL IT OUT BY HAND DURING ANY CONVEN-IENT THAW IN JANUARY OR FEBRUARY.

SOME—of these comments are free and some may cost you a little dough if you follow them—AND—some may even save you a little dough such as the next one.

PRUNING—If the weather is fitting rune the apples, pears, peaches, most shade trees, etc. BUT—KEEP YOUR FEET ON THE GROUND. In other words, let someone else climb if it is necessary. If an axe is needed be sure you realize that a limb (of a tree) is tougher than your own.

TULIPS & DAFFODILS—Not so much now, perhaps, but during thaws in February cover them (no, not the thaws... the Eccentric can cover all the thaws) with two to three inches of VERMICULITE, PEAT MOSS or compost.

BY-THE-WAY . . . When you see a product in CAPI-TAL letters it means that you can buy it here.

DORMANT SPRAY—Although unseemly it is not untimely to bring this subject to your attention. Dormant spraying with SCALECIDE (note the caps) is one of the most important bug sprays of the year. All you have to do spick a time between now and when spring growth begins when-the temperature will REMAIN ABOVE FREEZING FOR TWELVE (12) (XII) HOURS.

SEEDS—If you have a cool sunny window you can watch them—you can start Double Petunias, Vinca Rosea (we must find out what this is) and other slow growing annuals. Don't start the small petunias, marigolds and fast growing annuals until later.

REPOT—foliage plants and ferns because soon the stronger light will start new growth. A bit of fertilizer and water will be a fine investment.

DO NOT ALLOW—the newsboys, milkman, children, your wife or the dog (big heavy dog) to make a path on your fozen lawn... otherwise, the ground will be compacted and the grass severely damaged.
