

SOUTHFIELD HI NOTES

A graduate of the University of Michigan, Miss Mary Markos has joined the Southfield high school teaching staff, to teach world history. On a part time basis, Joe Dunham has joined the teaching staff at Lederle school. He will be a fulltime counselor in the fall.

Today is deadline for sign-up and deposits on the Southfield senior trip. As of Monday, only 28 seniors had signed up for the boat trip. Unless 150 have indicated interest by the close of school today, the trip will be cancelled.

Try-outs for "Love is Eternal" the Southfield spring drama production were held the first three days of this week. Daniel Julien, director, will announce the cast next week.

Southfield debate team finished in third place in the Interlakes conference this season. With the start of the second semester, interlakes forensics will begin in all five divisions. A local schoolwide contest will be held Feb. 25 with two winners chosen in each of the fields of dramatic reading, humorous reading, extemporaneous speaking, original content and interpretive reading. Winners will compete in the Interlakes contest, while one in each classification will be sent to compete in the regional contest.

Speaker at an assembly to be held on Feb. 27 will be Glenn Cunningham, former Olympic distance runner and onetime holder of the two mile world record. Cunningham, badly burned as a youngster, overcame a handicap that almost prevented him from walking. Theme of his talk will be "Temperance."

Southfield High Proposes Four For Summer Abroad

In Southfield high school's first year to participate in the American Field Service summer exchange program for junior students, a selection committee has recommended four students to AFS New York headquarters. They are Ken Almas, Mary Bush, Patricia Cordell, and Betty Savalva, according to an announcement made this week. Only one of the four can be selected for the eight-week stay with a family abroad. Southfield high school becomes eligible to participate in the plan, since this year the school has an AFS foreign exchange student attending classes.
