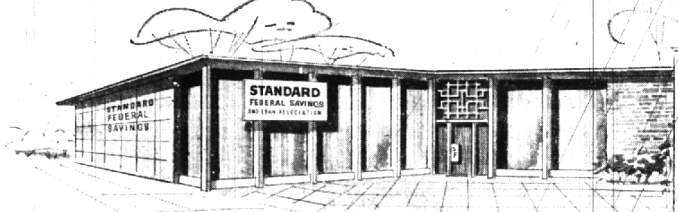

A DESK WHICH COMBINES not only a stand-up desk, but also a display of Association's literature pertaining to savings accounts and home financing.

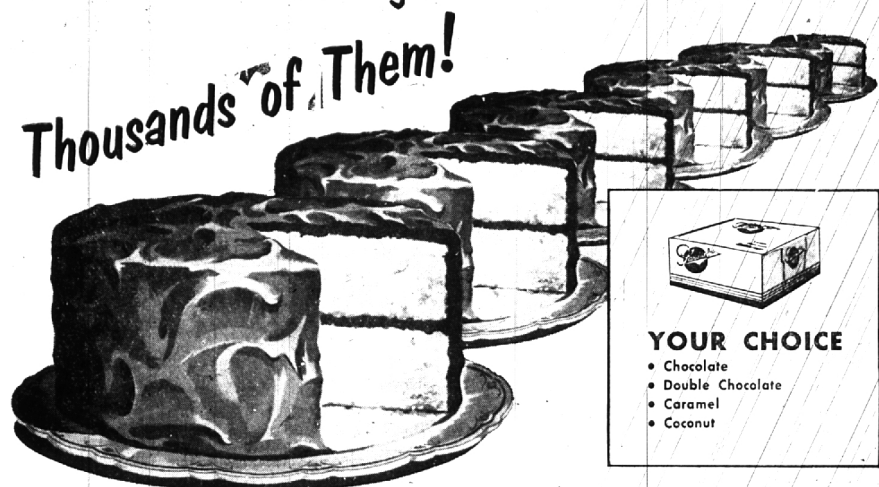

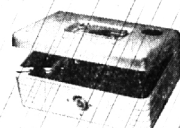
