## American Little League Results

The Fourth of July game inaugurated a new "clump down" policy by umpires towards players and managers.

Urged by Babe Ruth Board of Directors to watch for body contact and foul raising, the umpires pulled Spartan catcher Jay Madonna from the game when he disrupted a play by putting a charge to "wake up."

Later, over a particularly controversial call on a catch made by Spartan center-fielder Rod Ruddy, who dove, caught or trapped the ball, the Spartan manager John Madonna got into hot water.

THE UMPIRE allowed a hit and Madonna howled, claiming that Ruddy had possession of the ball. After a heated discussion the Spartan manager also was taken from the game.

The emphasis on courteous play is an old story in Babe Ruth circles. It is mirrored in the comment that "I don't feel that an umpire's decision should be questioned," he said.
