32 School Bus Drivers Briefed In Safety Program

Birmingham school bus drivers recently completed a twelve hour course of instruction in proper bus operation under the direction of David H. Soule, field services coordinator, from Eastern Michigan college, and Homer A. Earl, consultant, from Western Michigan University.

The 32 bus drivers met for their instruction at Torry school on E. Lincoln from 7 to 11 a.m. each morning for three days.

With more than 5300 school buses in operation on the highways of Michigan, this program was undertaken to improve the performance of school bus operators with the safety of the school children as a major objective.

Highway safety, first aid, Michigan vehicle code were among the subjects taught. Trooper Wade, of the Pontiac post, went over a test on the motor vehicle code and covered pertinent sections which deal with school buses.
