MEOWWWW.....

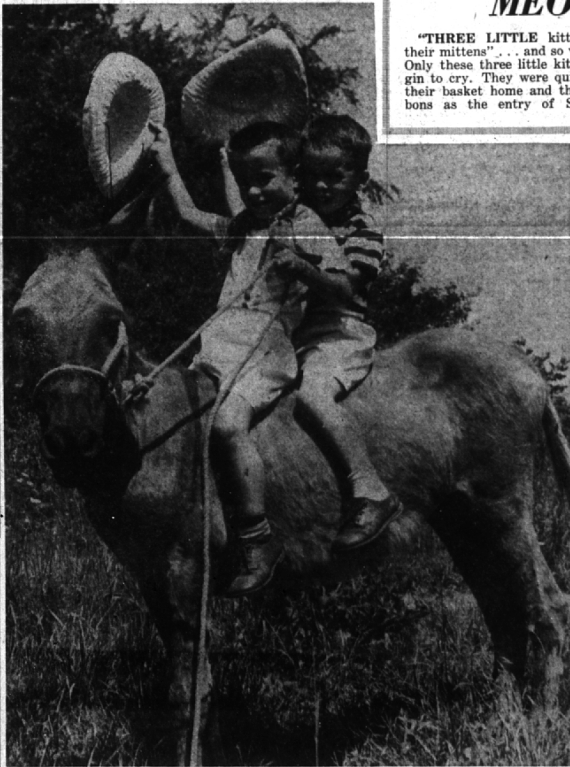
