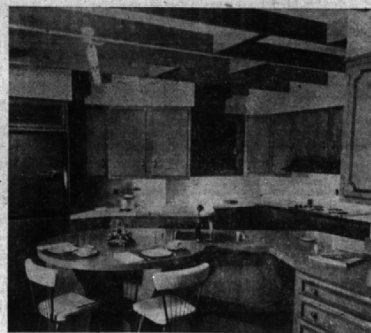
From May, 1955 until June, 1956, he was assistant manager of the division's advertising department. He then served as truck advertising coordinator.

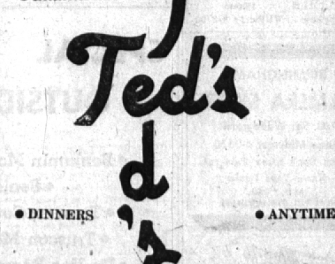
