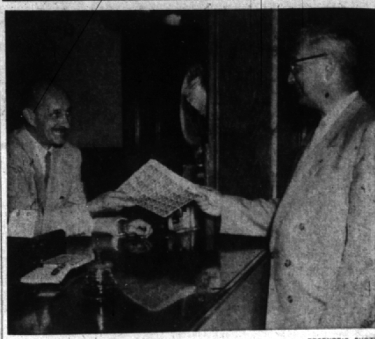

Youths Appeal 60-Day Jail Sentences

Sentences of 60 days in jail were handed down Friday in the case of the recalcitrant youth who fought Birmingham police arrest after their speeding car was halted on Woodward avenue recently. The youths have appealed to circuit court and are now free on bond.

Judge John J. Griffin fined Roger Boyte, 19, of Ferndale, \$50 and \$10 costs along with the jail sentence, after he pleaded guilty to resisting arrest and being drunk and disorderly.

Robert H. McCloskey, 19, of Troy; Richard Keating, 20, of Ferndale, and Gerald Hoxie, 21, of Ferndale, were fined \$25 and \$5 costs in addition to the jail sentences. All pleaded guilty to resisting arrest and being drunk and disorderly.

Boyte's bond was set at \$200, while the other three are free on \$100 bond.

A fifth youth involved, Patrick W. Keaton, 17, of Ferndale, was fined \$25 and \$5 costs Wednesday after pleading guilty to the same charge. A 60-day jail sentence was suspended, and the enlistee was turned over to Royal Canadian Air Force officials at Windsor.
