**Adopt Rules For Emergency Use of Water**

The Birmingham city commission this week adopted the same water restrictions for sprinkling purposes as the city of Detroit has. They will not be put into effect until the weather and water use require them.

According to L. R. Gare, director of public works, it is very doubtful, unless extreme hot weather prevails for a protracted period, that these regulations will be necessary.

Because Birmingham receives some of its water from Detroit, residents are required by contract to abide by Detroit water board regulations.

IF THEY should become necessary, they will apply only between the period from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. Odd numbered houses may water on the odd calendar dates, and even numbered houses on the even calendar dates.

There are no limitations on use of water on Sundays.
