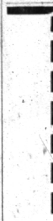

### 1st Traub Scholarship Winners to See Europe

Two graduating seniors of Bloomfield Hills high school are Traub scholarship winners Arthur Plaxton and Susan Kennedy.

Each is receiving \$850 toward expenses under terms of the scholarship established a year ago by Mrs. Traub in honor of her husband, who died in 1950, in recognition of his interest in art and music and his efforts to encourage the cultivation and expression of artistic and musical talents.

Arthur Plaxton, 920 Southdown, Birmingham, music award recipient, has chosen to spend two months in the home of a German family in Stuttgart.

SUSAN KENNEDY, 4905 Stoneleigh, Bloomfield Hills, art winner is joining an art and music student tour of eight countries. Under terms of the intentionally liberal award, both Susan and Arthur plotted their own itineraries with approval of teachers and parents.

For Arthur the award is one of a triad of honors. He is valedictorian of his class and has been awarded a recent scholarship to University of Michigan. He plans to begin a liberal arts course there this fall.

BEFORE HE MATRICULATES, however, he will have gained the benefits of two months in Europe. In establishing the scholarship Mrs. Traub specified that it is intended to "contribute to the general cultural enrichment of the recipients, and not primarily to advancement of their technical education in art or music."

SUSAN, WHO plans to major in art, will join a United States National Student association tour group of about 25 students June 29, New York.
