JUNE JOSTLE

Well! Good weather is here at last (except for the last 14 days) and you are relaxed and ready to enjoy your golf, fishing, etc.—BUT! Before you leave there are a few things we must tell you. If we don't tell you now, when you return you may scream to high heaven and say "Well, that was lousy-ay advice you gave us in April". So, here we go again...

LAWNS:
Reseeding can be ignored. However, if you have to seed a few bare spots or areas because you are having a garden party or wedding reception:—

1. Loosen the soil with a cultivator (man or TOOL)
2. Sprinkle a bit of CENTRAL STATES seed
3. Rake in the seed and pat it down
4. Cover with 1/4 inch of PEAT MOSS
5. Water every other day
6. Don't call up and say, "You louse"

The Fertilizing cannot be ignored:—

1. Spread AGRICO or STADLER'S XXX or WOODRUFF'S GRO-SOD at the rate of 2 lbs. to 100 sq. ft. BE SURE to water it off the blades of grass after each spreaderful have been distributed.
2. A new AGRICO UREAFORM 10-6-4 is now available at \$6.50 for 80 lbs. It is NON-BURNING. (The cost per sq. ft. is .00035 cents more than for the stuff mentioned in (1).)

WEEDS:
It may be too late to catch all the crabgrass seeds as some of them are now plants. However, the emergence control we have recommended can still be used and will eliminate a high percentage (depending on the care with which you apply it) of the seeds which have not been able to get going at this date.

The material is CHLORDANE—48%—the trade name is BONIDE-GARDANE. The rate of application is one pint to 2000 square feet.

If you are sure you have crabgrass plants already started get at them right away with:—
CRAB-NOT (Potassium Cyanate)
CRAB-NOT SPECIAL (P.C. plus 2-D)
ORTHO LIQUID CRABGRASS KILLER (Sedar)

(Consult an authority on this subject. There are some at 850 S. Woodward Ave. These people are really cool).

GRASS SEED:
Except for small bare spots and areas that can be smothered with attention we suggest that you wait until late August for reseeding activity.

WEEDS-IN-THE-GARDEN:
BUCKWHEAT HULLS appear to be the most efficient material to control this problem with the least amount of effort. The spreading of B.W. Hulls about 1" to 1 1/2" deep:

1. Holds down the weeds
2. Permits the penetration to subsurface of:—
A. Nourishment
B. Water
C. Air

How can you beat it? With a good cultivator or a gardener.

RUTABAGA:
Apparently we have offended more than one person by our disparaging remarks about this wee—this vegetable.

We apologize—and suggest that the vitamin content is good, similar to EGG PLANT, Dandelion and Turnips.

BARBECUE:
It is not too late to avail yourself of the penultimate in the backyard charring of good meat. With good equipment and a \$1.00 book you can slap up a side of beef that will be fun to eat and will get you a good many invitations to dine out.

BUGS:
In connection with the above you might remember that a mosquito can take the zest out of any good steak. To help eliminate this menace SPRAY your yard with D-D-IDE.

Scale insects are hatching. Spray all shrubs and trees having scales with MALATHION. Be sure to spray UNDERSIDE of leaves and stems. Spray FOUR TIMES about 10 days apart.
