B'ham P.O. To Raise Many Fees

Instructions to raise fees on special postal services were received this week by Birmingham Postmaster Roland F. Reese from the Postmaster General.

Effective July 1, the new fees cover such items as registered mail, money orders, special delivery, insured mail and special delivery of a first class letter formerly costing 20¢ would cost 30¢.

Some of the new fees, listed with former charges for comparison, are:

Plan to Build 4-Story Apartment Here Is Blocked

After protests voiced by James M. Crabbe, Jr., of 1114 Lakeside, Birmingham, planners last week recommended denial of the petition of Irwin I. Cohn, of Detroit, for rezoning of property adjacent to Crabbe's residence.

Cohn had petitioned for rezoning of the property on Woodward avenue south of Colonial court from terrace to a multiple family classification. The change would permit erection of a four-story apartment building on the site, which plan board Chairman Bennett Root said would be "a better use of the land."

Cohn's proposed structure was described as a "Whittier-type" building. Crabbe protested the height would make it offensive aesthetically when viewed from his property.

Rezoning Suit Must Start Over

Because the plaintiff failed to file his amended pleadings in time, there will be a new trial over the zoning of several lots on Southfield north of 14 Mile, Birmingham City Attorney Richard Adams said Monday.

Plaintiff Fred Graef's attorney had been given two weeks by Judge Clark Adams to amend trial pleadings. The deadline passed last week, said Adams.

The case now goes to the bottom of the docket, "and there's no telling when it will come up," he remarked.

Graef seeks to have the court determine that the lots' most reasonable use is business B. The city recently zoned them to business C (office - professional). Originally, the property was residential.
