### Do Not Mix Roses With Other Flowers

Have you checked over your property for safety hazards. The Number One location to study is your shrubbery and trees which border your driveway as it crosses the sidewalk and joins the street.

In modern planting we do not place shrubs near the joining of the driveway and street due to the safety hazard and our responsibility as home owners in case of an accident.

profile of the secondary limbs. Be sure to use a paint over the wounds for that purpose.

If your trees are important asset to your property remember they will benefit by feeding. About half way out from the trunk and the branch tips, drill holes by pounding a crowbar about 12-18 inches deep and feed with a fertilizer in soluble nitrogen. Follow this step by a soaking with water.

Speaking of feeding plant material, I am busy these days filling my sprinkling can with 2 tablespoons of Rapidgrow to a gallon of water and feeding all of the choice plants every three weeks to see how foliar feeding will work on ornamentals. Probably we will live in a jungle before the season is over. It is fun trying new ideas in the garden.

The way roses are merchandised these days you can purchase them anytime and add them to your garden to provide that "plus" style.

It is good practice to not mix roses with other types of flowers due to their specialized care, especially no overhead watering, (cause of blackspot).

When you cut roses for your home be sure and take off as few leaves as possible. Make the cut just above the leaf and sloping away from it, use a knife, not scissors which will bind together the end of the stem, preventing natural flow of water.

If you wish to grow very big roses you remove the smaller buds below the rose bud at the tip of a branch.

MANY OF OUR local rose specialists always paint the cuts when they have removed canes when pruning their roses with tree paint to prevent borers entering later in the season.

If you wish to display roses for hospitality or in competition it is advisable to cut the specimens the night before and store in a dark cool room without drafts. In England they practice a technique called "tying in". Soft wool yarn is used and when the bud has the outer row of petals just beginning to curl the inner bud is skillfully

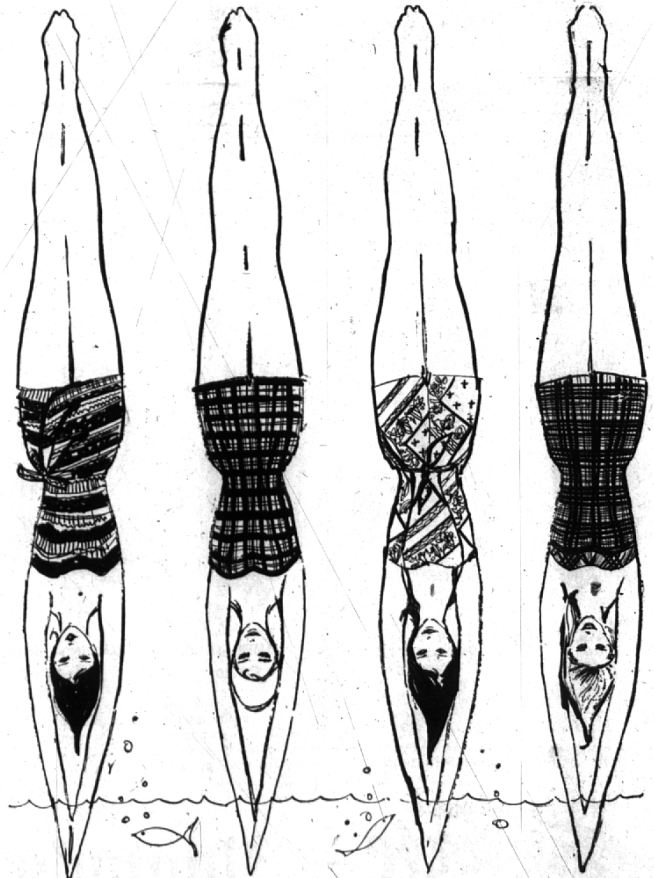

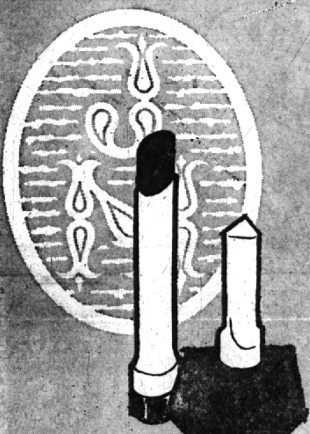
