## Measures Okay By Commission

Traffic volumes do not warrant stopping southbound Woodward traffic in favor of Oak cross-street, the police department recommended to the Birmingham city commission.

Commissioners accepted it, then approval department suggestions to remove the red arrow signal at the southwest corner Maple and Woodward for a 30-day trial. If it aids pedestrian safety, it will not be re-installed, the commission agreed.

A NEW pedestrian walk across Woodward on the south side of Willis also gained commission approval, as did yield right-of-way signs on Haynes and Hazel at Bowers. Truck traffic also will be prohibited over these three streets.

While traffic volumes warrant installation of signals at Pierce and Brown, the commission believes its next year's funds must be spent on signal installations at Greenfield and 14 Mile, and at Adams and US-10.

## Business Use for Lots on 14 Mile

A more restrictive business use of property along the north side of 14 Mile, east from Woodward, will be considered at a public hearing Birmingham city commissioners have set for July 15.

Fifteen of the lots, now zoned business A, are either vacant or are being used for business C purposes (medical, dental, clinics, etc.).

At a public hearing, the commission can reduce the amount of rezoning, but cannot enlarge the size of the district under consideration.
