TROY — A 17-year-old Avon township youth drowned Sunday morning in a spring-fed gravel pit in Troy as he and three other companions, all apparently non-swimmers, were playing in water over their heads, police report.

The victim was identified by Troy police as Harvey Gray of 2700 Dearborn street, a Rochester address. The mishap occurred shortly after 11 a.m. at Spring Water picnic park on Beach road off South boulevard.

Police said the youth and three companions were in water over their heads, keeping afloat by hanging onto a log. Troy police reported the four splashed around and headed the log to shore and when they touched bottom, they began walking to shore.

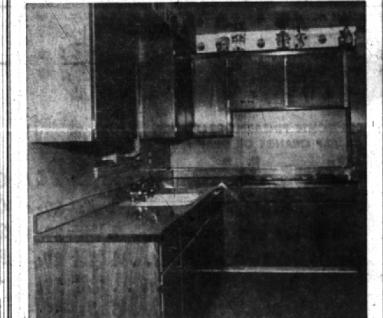
OFFICERS SAID the Gray youth apparently stepped into a hole. He grabbed two companions and the struggle was noticed by the life guard, Albert E. Knudson,
