November 1955—An additional 2.81 acres adjoining the Callow property mentioned above was acquired without premium from and through the consideration of M. Heim.

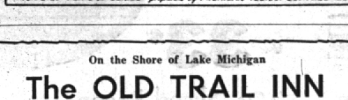
