

Cranbrook Art Academy Awards 4 Scholarships

Four scholarships, valued at \$1400 each, have been awarded by Cranbrook Academy of Art, Bloomfield Hills, to two Japanese and two Americans.

Masao Shiina, a 28-year-old architect from Tokyo, will receive the Eliel Saarinen scholarship. He is a graduate of Waseda University, Tokyo, and for five years has been a practicing architect in Japan.

Tsuneko Yokota, recipient of the Ellen Scripps Booth scholarship, is a 30-year-old weaver from Japan, a graduate of Tama College of Fine Arts, Tokyo, and for the past three years engaged in textile design and research.

THE GEORGE G. BOOTH memorial award goes to Jack Madison, 30, a painter from Waukegan, Wis. This spring he will receive a bachelor's degree from the Layton School of Art, Milwaukee. Last month his paintings were shown in the "Young America" exhibition at the Whitney Museum, New York.

Sculptor James Brewer, 24, of North Carolina, was awarded the James Scripps Booth scholarship. He will come to Cranbrook from the University of North Carolina where he attended school, and is now an assistant teacher in sculpture and ceramics.

The scholarships, which cover the academy's 1957-58 school year, were established in memory of George and Ellen Booth, founders of the six Cranbrook Institutions; Eliel Saarinen, first head of the academy; and James Scripps Booth, for many years an academy trustee.

Cranbrook Theatre School Announces Staff Additions

Allen Manstir, as technical director, and Rachel Berrope as costume director, both from the Cranbrook Academy of Art, have been added to the summer staff of the Cranbrook Theatre school, according to announcement made by Carl G. Womberger, director. Returning to the 26-man staff of the school will be Patricia Belfore, head of dramatics at Berkeley high school, and Barbara Hamel, formerly producer and owner of the Salsine Mills theatre.

Local staff members for the year will include Sara Smith, Marcia McIntock, Carolyn Hinton, Carol Torrey, Barbara Bigge, Cherie Seibert, and Jo Burr Fredrickson. The Theatre school, which has its home in the Cranbrook Greek theatre and Pavilion, will include work in spring, dancing, directing, make-up, pantomime and stage technique. It will include about 125 students ranging in age from 9 through 23. Credit is offered where desired.

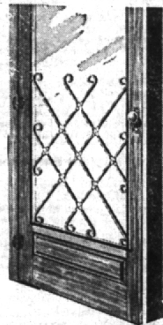

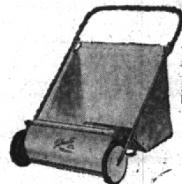

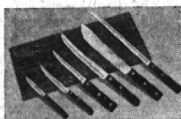
